REPORT OF THE COUNCIL

The Councillors present their report on the state of affairs of the Hospital at 30th June, 1983 and on the surplus for the year then ended.

We report that there was a surplus for the year of	26,610
from which has been subtracted the debit balance of the Maintenance Account	63,086
to leave an accumulated deficit of	<u>\$36,476</u>

The undermentioned transfers to and from provisions were made during the year before arriving at the surplus of \$26,610 reported above:—

The principal activity of the Hospital during the course of the year was to act as a public hospital and pre-school centre.

In accordance with the requirements of the Companies (Victoria) Code, the Councillors state that:—

- (a) Before the statement of profit and loss and balance sheet of the Hospital were made out all reasonable steps were taken by the Councillors to ascertain what action had been taken in relation to the writing off of bad debts. All known bad debts have been written off and it has not been considered necessary to increase the provision for doubtful debts. At the date of this report the Councillors are not aware of any circumstances which would render the amount written off for bad debts or the provision for doubtful debts to be inadequate to any substantial extent.
- (b) Before the statement of profit and loss and balance sheet of the Hospital were made out all reasonable steps were taken by the Councillors to ascertain whether any current assets (other than sundry debtors) were unlikely to realize, in the ordinary course of business, their value as shown in the accounting records of this Company. At the date of this report the Councillors are unaware of any circumstances which would render the value attributed to the current assets in the accounts misleading.
- (c) At the date of this report there is:—
 - (i) No charge on the assets of the Hospital which has arisen since 30th June, 1983 and which secures the liabilities of any other person.
 - (ii) No contingent liability has arisen since 30th June, 1983.
- (d) No contingent or other liability of the Hospital has become enforceable or is likely to become enforceable within the period of twelve months from 30th June, 1983 which, in the opinion of the Councillors, will or may substantially affect the ability of the Hospital to meet its obligations as and when they fall due.
- (e) During the financial year ended 30th June, 1983, the results of the operations of the Hospital were not in the opinion of the Councillors, substantially affected by any item, transaction or event of a material or unusual nature.
- (f) No item, transaction or event of a material or unusual nature has arisen in the interval between 30th June, 1983 and the date of this report which, in the opinion of the Councillors, will affect substantially the results of the operation of the Hospital for the year ended 30th June, 1984.
- (g) At the date of this report the Councillors are not aware of any circumstances not otherwise dealt with in the report or accounts which would render any amount stated in the accounts misleading.
- (h) Since the end of the previous financial year, except for Mr. W. A. Jamieson, a Councillor whose firm acts as printer to the Hospital, no Councillor has received or become entitled to receive any benefit (as defined in Section 270(7) of the Companies (Victoria Code) by reason of a contract made by the Hospital with a director or a firm of which he is a member or with a Company in which he has a substantial financial interest.

We are all grateful for the loyal and dedicated service to the Hospital.

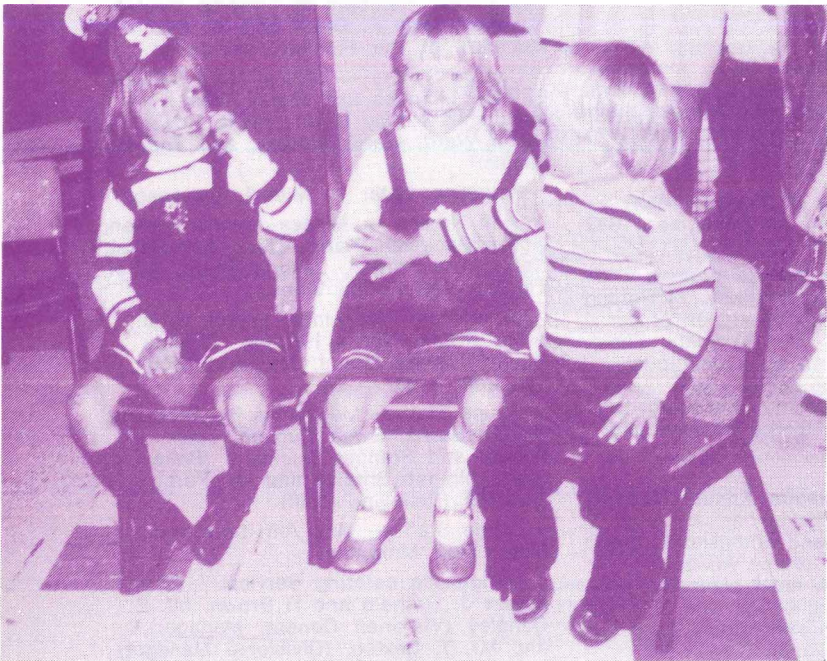

Merited Honors For Two



We are delighted to record that two of Tweddle's devoted and dedicated workers have been made life members of the hospital they have served for so long.

Miss May Angliss,

M.B.E.

May Angliss was Honorary Secretary of the Central Auxiliary of "The Tweddle Baby Hospital" for 21 years from 1934 to 1955 and President of that Auxiliary for 28 years from 1955 to 1983.

May has held important offices in the Central Auxiliary for a continuous period of 49 years.

Such a record of outstanding service is remarkable and is unlikely ever to be exceeded by any other member of the Central Auxiliary.

During May Angliss' period of office as President of the Central Auxiliary the sum of \$63,906 was raised for the Tweddle Baby Hospital.

In addition to the above sum all collections by members of the Central Auxiliary on Street Appeal Days for the Melbourne "Lord Mayor's Fund" were remitted to "Tweddle" from that Fund.

May Angliss has also been President of the "Children's Welfare Association of Victoria". She was awarded the M.B.E. in 1963 by H.M. the Queen in recognition of her community service.

We thank May for all she has accomplished for "Tweddle".

New Auxiliary President

Mrs. Joan Mercer was appointed President of the Central Auxiliary of The Tweddle Baby Hospital at the Auxiliary's Annual Meeting on the 17th August, 1983. Mrs. Mercer was formerly Deputy Chairwoman from 1973.

Dr. J. Glyn White,

C.B.E., E.D., M.B., B.S., F.R.A.C.P., F.A.M.A.

After graduation from Melbourne University in 1935, Dr. J. Glyn White was pursuing his post-graduate studies in London when the Second World War broke out.

By 1941 he had attained the rank of Lieutenant-Colonel and was Assistant Director of Medical Services for the A.I.F. in Malaya. With the Japanese occupation of Malaya he became a prisoner of war in Changi for 3½ years. He was Medical Officer in Charge of British, Australian and Dutch P.O.W. Medical Services at Changi.

In 1946 he commenced general practice in Melbourne and was appointed to the Royal Children's Hospital. In 1948 he was appointed Medical Officer-in-Charge of the Cerebral Palsy Clinic at the Children's and became a specialist pediatrician. Other appointments he has held include Honorary Neo-Natal Pediatrician at the Footscray and District Hospital, 1954-59.

Honorary Pediatrician to the Royal Women's Hospital 1960-69 and Chairman of the National Blood Transfusion Committee of the Australian Red Cross Society.

In 1960 he was awarded the C.B.E. by H.M. the Queen in recognition of his services during the 'flu epidemic.

Dr. White commenced work at Tweddle in 1948 and became a member of the Hospital Committee in 1955. In 1974, he was elected junior Vice President, and in 1981 senior Vice President.

For 35 years he has given devoted and outstanding service to the hospital.

We all owe a great debt to Dr. White for his long and dedicated service to Tweddle.
